Proper endoscopic tissue sampling and resection is critical for diagnosis, treatment and surveillance in gastrointestinal disease. During the last few years a great variety of techniques and devices for endoscopic sampling and resection have been developed in order to provide more definitive and accurate diagnosis and treatment. Correct and comprehensive lesion characterization by the endoscopist is crucial for selecting the most appropriate endoscopic device and resection technique. This choice, in turn, considerably affects the subsequent histopathologic analysis, the final diagnosis, and ultimately the required surveillance. This meeting has the purpose to discuss the state of the art and future perspectives of tissue sampling and endoscopic resection in gastrointestinal endoscopy, focusing on potential applications of the most recently developed devi-

ces and techniques.
